



2005 CABERNET FRANC Rattlesnake Hills

VINEYARD NOTES: This is the first release of our Estate-grown Cabernet Franc. The vines produced a small crop of highly concentrated fruit. 2005 was a vintage year in the Rattlesnake Hills AVA with 2778 growing degree-days. This puts the AVA solidly in region II, just like the Napa Valley.
