



**2006 CABERNET SAUVIGNON**  
Yakima Valley

**VINEYARD NOTES:** This is a blend of our two Cabernet Sauvignon vineyards. The Château Puryear vineyard is noted for soft tannins and ripe flavors. The Morrison Vineyard is distinguished by bright fruit and rich tannins. A little Cabernet Franc jazzes up the nose. The blend is perfect.
